

## *Young Artist Scholarship Competition*

### **Application Information**

#### Audition Requirements:

- All competition participants will be chosen on a first come, first serve basis.
- High school applicants must be enrolled in grades 9-12 and studying in Missouri or Illinois. College/adult applicants must be of at least eighteen years of age.
- All applications must be signed by a private flute teacher or band director verifying that the applicant is prepared for the competition.
- If chosen, the performer is required to play the work listed on the application.
- All applicants must be current members of the Flute Society of St. Louis.
- A one-paragraph biographical sketch must be included with the audition materials. *Email is preferred. Please send to [flutesocietyofsaintlouis@gmail.com](mailto:flutesocietyofsaintlouis@gmail.com)*
- The decision of the judges is final.
- All applicants must be available to perform on the specified competition date from 1:30-5:00pm.

#### General information:

- The competition will be held on Saturday, February 23rd at the Trinity Presbyterian Church in St. Louis, MO.
- Applicants will be divided into 2 divisions: high school (grades 9-12) and college/adult (eighteen years and older).
- Each chosen participant will perform for the judge in a masterclass format and receive both spoken and written comments after their performance.
- Winners will be chosen from both divisions. Winners from the high school and college/adult divisions will receive scholarship awards.
- Applicants chosen to participate in the competition must limit their performance to 10-15 minutes (depending on the division), making cuts if necessary.
- Applicants chosen to participate in the competition will be notified by February 8th, 2007.
- All works written with accompaniment must be performed with accompaniment.

#### The following must be received by **Friday, February 1st, 2007**:

- Completed entry form, including signatures of private teacher and parent (if applicable)
- One-paragraph biographical sketch (if not sent via email)
- Registration fee: \$30 in the form of a check or money order
- \$12.50 FSSL Student Membership dues, if not a current member
- Self-addressed, stamped, business-size envelope
